- Please note, selection does not guarantee a student will be enrolled in all classes they select, especially options. Options offered may change based on the amount of student interest and other instructional needs within the school.
- Student Scheduling Guidelines
o $\mathbf{5}$ credit courses = $\mathbf{2}$ blocks and $\mathbf{3}$ credit courses $=1$ block
o Grade 10 students must enroll in a full schedule. A full schedule includes a total of 16 blocks for the school year.

PE 10 and CALM are graduation requirements and are recommended to be taken in grade 10.
o Grade 11 students must complete a minimum of 75 cumulative credits and are able to take up to two spares. (need a minimum of 14 blocks).
o Grade 12 students must complete a minimum of 100 cumulative credits.
o Students are responsible for ensuring they have the necessary pre-requisites before enrolling in a course. Please see the program guide for information on pre-requisites or check at the office.

- We offer an accelerated version of Math 20-3/30-3 in one semester. (2 blocks)
